## Message from the Executive Director

In addition to switching our fiscal year to follow the calendar year, the Urbandale Food Pantry has had an exciting past six months! The following is just a sampling of our good news:

 Through collaboration with the Des Moines Area Religious Council (DMARC) and the Polk County Health Services for the Partnership for a Hunger Free Polk County, the Urbandale Food Pantry was able extend its hours and hire an additional employee. Our new hours of operation are Monday-Thursday 9:30 A.M.-6:30 P.M. and Saturdays 8:00 A.M.-12:00 P.M.



- The UFP received a \$25,000.00 grant from the Burk Foundation to purchase a walk-in freezer for Thanksgiving turkeys and meat donations throughout the year
- The Gabus Cares Foundation awarded the UFP a grant of \$25,200.00, which allows us to continue giving personal care items to our neighbors in need for the next year
- Endow Urbandale donated \$3,000.00 to the UFP for a trailer to pick up food donations
- Allegra's FootPrint Foundation created and printed a flier to inform clients of social services in the area
- A bumper crop of fruit and vegetables helped feed many families in the summer and fall
